

ELIZABETH FARM HOUSE TOUR



Visit Historical Elizabeth Farm House a rare example of an early Australian Colonial Bungalow built in 1793 for John & Elizabeth Macarthur, pioneers of the Australian Wool Industry.

Elizabeth Farm is a unique museum that allows visitors to experience life in the early 18005 through open rooms and "hands on" experiences. The Homesteads deep shaded verandahs overlook a beautiful recreated colonial garden containing trees from the first years of settlement — including Australia's oldest European olive trees.

Enjoy a guided tour or wander at your own pace. Pull up a chair before an open fire, sit on furniture, leaf through family letters and enjoy the changing displays as the tales of history and passion come to life.

After your tour & exploring the museum and gardens relax in the Tearooms for a Traditional Devonshire Tea.

Then rejoin the coach for a Historic Tour of Parramatta and Parramatta Park Then lunch at Parramatta RSL
